

## **CODE OF CONDUCT**

## **MISSION STATEMENT**

Williamson County Republican Leaders (WCRL) shall advance the ideals of the Republican Party as well as train Republican leaders for public service, particularly in Williamson County, Texas.

## **POLICY**

It is a tremendous responsibility and honor to be a member of the Williamson County Republican Leaders. Members, endorsed candidates, and endorsed holders of public office shall:

- **1. Activity:** be active participants in WCRL committees and functions as well as promote WCRL and the Republican Party.
- **2. Integrity:** have strong moral principles including honesty, trustworthiness, and uphold the values of WCRL and the Republican Party to the best of their ability at all times.
- **3. Accountability:** be held accountable for their decisions and actions that affect WCRL, the Republican Party, and/or the reputation of either.
- **4. Leadership:** lead by example, encourage other members, address poor behavior appropriately, keep decorum, and behave professionally and respectfully.
- **5. Cooperation:** cooperate fully with any process set forth by the WCRL Board should a grievance occur.

## **CAUSE FOR REVOCATION OF MEMBERSHIP**

Without prejudice to its privileges and responsibilities under the Bylaws, the Board enumerates the following non-exhaustive list of behavior that may, at the Board's discretion, be cause for termination of membership in WCRL:

- Harassment or threats of harassment against WCRL or any Member, Guest, Speaker, or Host Facility.
- Fraud, libel, or slander of WCRL or any Member, Guest, Speaker, or Host Facility
- Unethical or illegal behavior inside or outside WCRL activities that impugns the reputation WCRL or any Member, Guest, Speaker, or Host Facility
- Embezzlement of WCRL funds or the use of WCRL funds without Board approval
- Misuse of real or intangible WCRL property (e.g., personal data of Members) for non-WCRL-related purpose
